In this role you are expected to attend and participate in our two annual Executive Council Meetings, that traditionally take place the day before our spring Semi-Annual Meeting and our fall Annual Meeting. You are also expected to volunteer for dental promotions throughout your term and afterwards. Thank you.

The New Dentist Committee meetings are held every other month via conference call. The meetings are usually held the first Wednesday of the month at noon. As soon as possible after each meeting, send your report the Sixth District Dental Society Executive Director.

This committee is a standing committee of the Council on Membership and Communications.

A new dentist is a dentist who graduated from dental school with a D.D.S. or a D.M.D. degree less than ten (10) years prior to their service on any Council.

The duties of the Committee on New Dentist shall be:

The New Dentist Committee shall recommend to the Board of Trustees all new dentist nominees for Council service. The term of service of new dentist members on any Council shall be two (2) years. The total number of allowable terms of service of any new dentist member on a Council shall be two (2) two-year terms. New dentist members of any Council shall serve in that capacity only for as long as they remain qualified as new dentist members as defined in the NYSDA Constitution and Bylaws.
